ISCED-97 The International Standard Classification of Education. Educational programmes are classified into levels and fields of education.

LEVELS OF EDUCATION IN THE SYSTEM OF EDUCATION OF REPUBLIKA SRPSKA ACCORDING TO ISCED-97

ISCED 0 Covers children in preschool education aged at least three years, until their entry into primary education.

ISCED 1 Covers basic education of pupils in "lower grades" I–IV until school year 2003/2004, and after that in grades I–V.

ISCED 2 Covers basic education of pupils in "higher grades" V–VIII until school year 2003/2004, and after that in grades VI–IX.

ISCED 3 This level of education usually begins after completion of full-time compulsory education. The entrance age to this level is typically 15 or 16 years. This

level of education is divided into two groups, depending on duration of education, as well as on possibility of direct entry to a higher level of education.

ISCED 3A Includes secondary schools of four years duration, and it allows for direct entry to the next higher level of education. This level covers all secondary schools of four years duration, such as grammar school, art schools, religious schools and vocational technical schools.

ISCED 3C Covers all secondary vocational schools of two or three years duration. This level leads directly to labour market or to other ISCED 3 level programmes.

ISCED 5 Covers higher education, including postgraduate and masters studies.

ISCED 6 Covers doctors of science.

ISCED-2011 The International Standard Classification of Education. Educational programmes are classified into levels and fields of education.

LEVELS OF EDUCATION IN THE SYSTEM OF EDUCATION OF REPUBLIKA SRPSKA ACCORDING TO ISCED-2011

ISCED 0 Early childhood education. There are two categories of ISCED level 0 programmes:

- Early childhood educational development programmes (programmes that has educational content designed for younger children aged 0 to 2 years), and

- Preschool education (programme is designed for children from the age of 3 years to the start of primary education).

ISCED 1 First stage of primary education includes primary education of pupils in "lower grades", namely grades 1 to 4 until the school year 2003/2004, and grades 1 to 5 afterwards.

ISCED 2 Second stage of primary education includes primary education of pupils in "higher grades", namely grades 5 to 8 until the school year 2003/2004, and grades 6 to 9 afterwards.

ISCED 3 Secondary education. This level of education usually begins after the completion of full obligatory education. Programmes which form the second/final stage of secondary education may be either general or vocational ISCED level 3 programmes. General education is defined as education programmes that are designed to develop learners' general knowledge, skills and competencies, to prepare participants for more advanced education programmes at the same of a higher level. Vocational education is defined as education programmes that are designed for learners to acquire the knowledge, skills and competencies specific to a particular occupation or class of occupations. Completion of such programmes leads to labour market-relevant vocational qualifications.

ISCED 4 Post-secondary non-tertiary education. Programmes at this level are not considered to be tertiary education and are typically vocational and terminal programmes that prepare for the labour market.

ISCED 5-8 Levels 5-8 refer to tertiary education.
